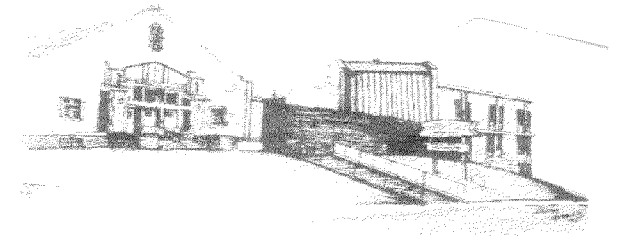

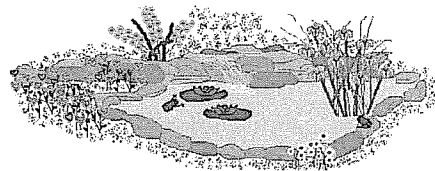

PLANT FOUR ROWS OF LETTUCE:

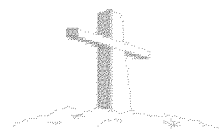
1. Lettuce be faithful

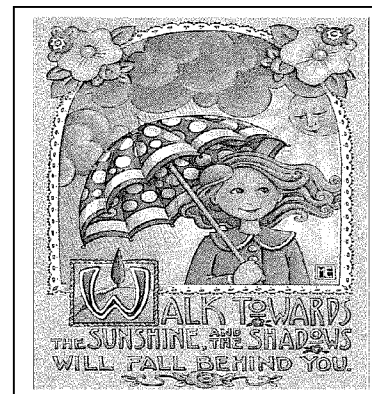
