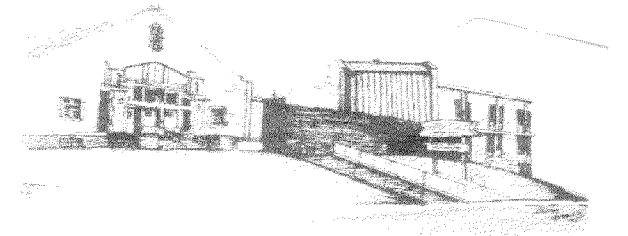

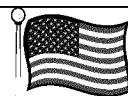

We need counselors for the fall retreat. Male and Female. Please see Tom or Granny if you are available to do this.

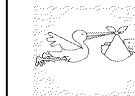
Kids for Christ
