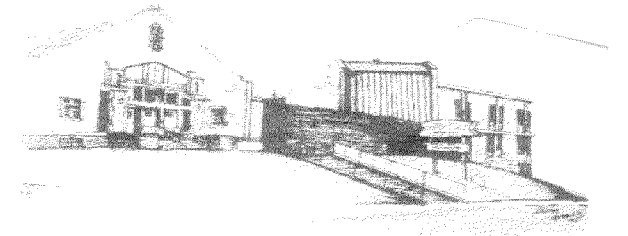

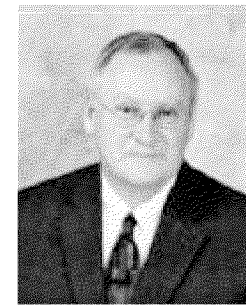

On Sunday evening the young men spoke on their experience at OU. Much was learned on this trip and the young men did a great job in telling us about it.

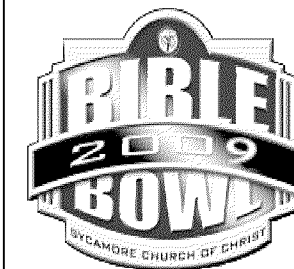
