How Did God Come To Be?

In **Psalm 90:2**, Moses is recorded as writing "Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God."

"From everlasting" means God had no beginning; "to everlasting" means God has no end. Speaking of God in **Psalm 93:2**, David said "thou art from everlasting", meaning God had no origin. In **Psalm 102:27**, David writes "But thou art the same, and Thy years shall have no end" a reference to the never ending nature of God.

John the apostle described Jesus in **Revelation 1:4** as "...Him who is and who was, and who is to come." That same description is found in **verse 8** of the same chapter. The Hebrew writer said "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever."

Jesus said of Himself in **John 8:58**, "before Abraham was, I AM." He claimed deity for Himself by claiming an eternal nature. "I AM" is the equivalent to saying, "I have always existed and will always exist." The Jews in that audience understood what He meant, that is why they tried to kill Him (**John 8:59**).

An eternal God is the only logical explanation for the existence of the universe. The universe cannot be eternal, neither could it create itself out of nothing. Even the ridiculous "Big Bang" theory requires the existence of matter and a force to make it happen. Therefore, the only rational, logical explanation for existence is God.

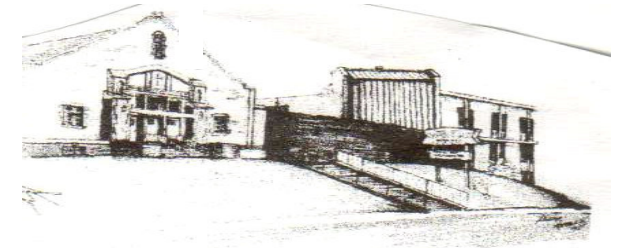
