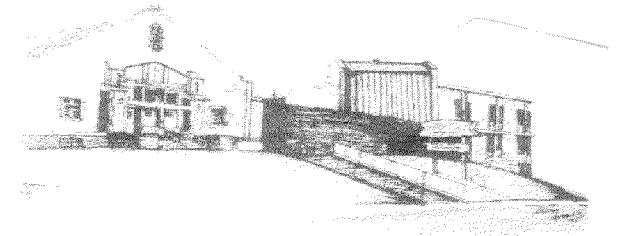

## CENTRAL AMERICAN MISSIONS

God permitting, Jay & Marilyn Wilkins & I will fly to Nicaragua on June 5 to participate in two mission Vacation Bible Schools & one week of a medical mission. This mission is under the direction of the elders at the East Ridge Church in Chattanooga where my daughter, Tiffany and her husband, Alan worship. This is the 17<sup>th</sup> year that East Ridge has conducted missions in Central America. The campaigns will be conducted in the cities of El Rama, La Ceiba, & Las Flores.

El Rama is a city of 5,000 & is at the juncture of 3 rivers that drain the eastern slopes of the Nicaraguan Mountains. A small port in Rama allows ships from the Caribbean Ocean to transport cattle, bananas, coffee, & other goods up & down river. A new 180-mile-road through the mountains links El Rama with Managua & is doing much to open up the Atlantic Coast. Several Indian tribes live on the Atlantic Coast including the Miskito Indians who speak English. The church there began in 2003 & has an attendance of 20. The East Ridge church supports their preacher. Las Flores is a suburb of Masaya, Nicaragua's 2<sup>nd</sup> largest city with a metropolitan population of about 317,000 people. The church began in 1998 & now has an attendance of 40. The Hartsville Pike church in Gallatin supports this work. The La Ceiba church began in 1989 and has an attendance of 60. The East Ridge church supports their preacher.

We are grateful for the outpouring of clothes, shoes, money, & words of encouragement for this trip. You have given more than what the airlines will allow us to carry. Thank you for your love for these people. We also are appreciative for the work of Mary Headrick, a travel agent who donated her time in booking our travel arrangements.

Thanks to Ralph Taylor & to the young men who will preach this Sunday (Thanks also to Tom Todd), & to Justin Rumford who will preach both services on June 14. Justin will also preach in a Gospel Meeting on June 8-9 at the Taylortown Church of Christ & Jim Skates will be leading singing.

At this writing, Julia Godwin is in Honduras working with the Mission Lazarus Project, a work developed by Jarrod Brown, a Nashville Christian businessman turned evangelist. Julia traveled to Choluteca, Honduras with about two-dozen members of the Crieve Hall Church of Christ for an evangelistic campaign based out of the Mission Lazarus Retreat Center, a 1250-acre ranch that has a medical clinic, farm, school, church, a warehouse, and community center. The White Bluff Church of Christ assisted Julia in her travel expenses. About a month ago, my brother, Kerry along with 24 men from the West Seventh St. Church of Christ in Columbia, conducted a week-long mission at the same place. He said it was the best mission trip he had been on.

Donnie Mosley will be traveling next month to the Mary Flakes de Flores Church of Christ in Tegucigalpa, Honduras to visit a preacher we support, bro. Julian Munoz. Donnie will be building houses for the poor.

Please pray for all these works.
