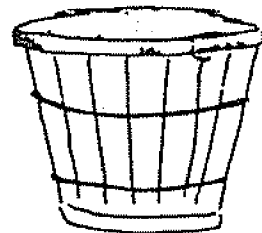

What's In Your Bucket?



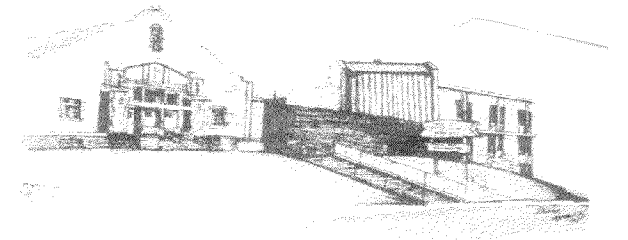
If you were walking from the well carrying a bucket of water and someone jostled you, there would be spilled from the bucket only what it contained.

What Did Jesus Believe About The Death Penalty?

In the state of Tennessee (as of Mar. 3, 2009), there are 87 prisoners in our penal system awaiting execution.

**2 of the 87 are women (2%),
36 are African-American (41%), and
49 are Caucasian (56%).**

These 87 people are known to have murdered 126 people.

One man murdered his wife with a skillet and a horseshoe.

Several were convicted for robbing the elderly before murdering them.

One man wounded two teenage boys before burying them alive where they died of injury and suffocation.

Another man shot his victim who survived two years before dying.

Numerous men on death row murdered children. Several pre-teen girls were raped, tortured, before being murdered. One man stabbed a 3-year-old girl to death. Another stabbed a 2-year-old baby to death.

One can only wonder about the childhood of these 87 death-row inmates. How many were victims of emotional, physical, and sexual abuse? Even though they took someone's life, they also were created in God's image.

Christians are called to have the same attitude toward men that Jesus had.

This Sunday evening at 5:00 P.M., we will consider what the Bible says, and what Jesus said about capital punishment. This topic should be of interest to those who are interested in improving society.

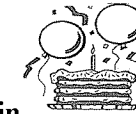
