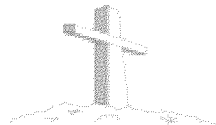

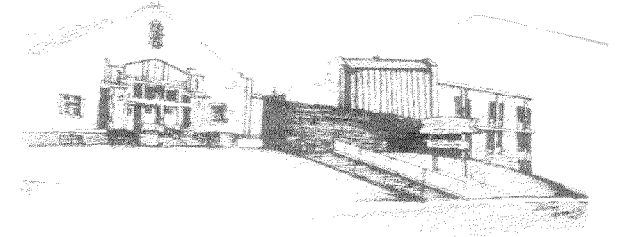

Seven Basic Guidelines For A Happy, Fulfilling & Meaningful Life

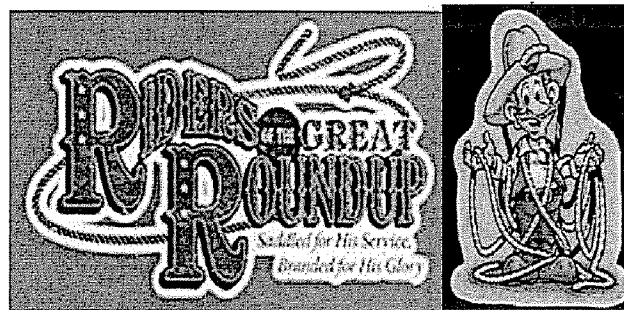

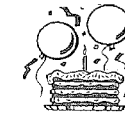
