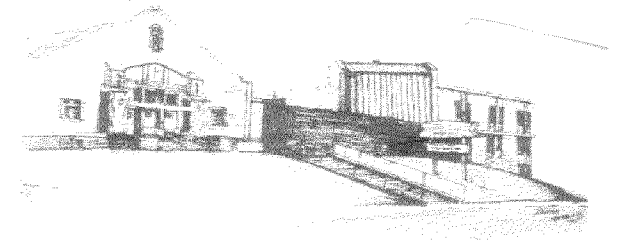

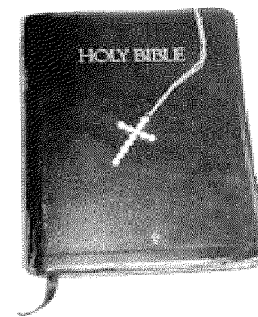

On October 11th we will be having a devotion at Karl and Janie Craun's house.

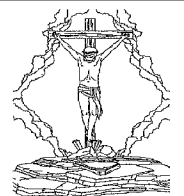
