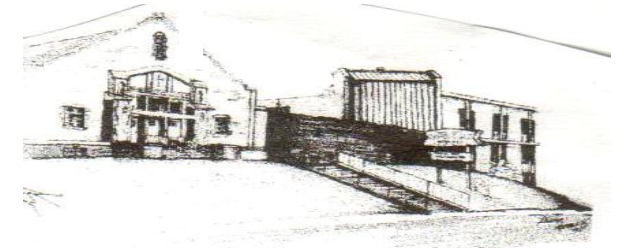

If a U.S. Census worker knocks on your door, they will have a badge, a handheld device, a Census Bureau canvas bag, and a confidentiality notice. Ask to see their identification and their badge before answering their questions. They will not ask for Social Security numbers, account or credit card numbers, nor will they solicit donations. *The only thing they will need to know is how many people live at your address.*
