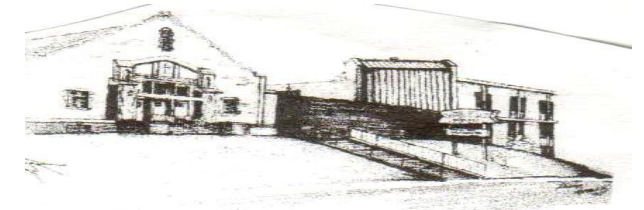

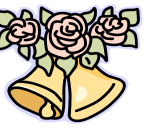

Bridal Showers



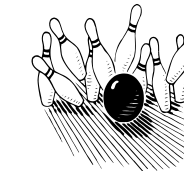
