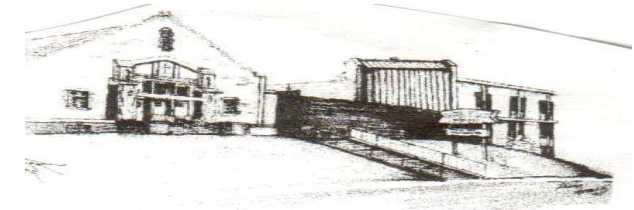

WHO IS IN CHARGE?

Daniel 4:31, 32

"King Nebuchadnezzar, to you it is declared: sovereignty has been removed from you, and you will be driven away from mankind, and your dwelling place will be with the beasts of the field. You will be given grass to eat like cattle, and seven periods of time will pass over you until you recognize that the Most High is ruler over the realm of mankind and bestows it on whomever He wishes."

Nebuchadnezzar was the most powerful man in the world and had conquered every nation around him. He made the mistake of associating Babylon's greatness with his strength. "Is this not Babylon the great, which I myself have built as a royal residence by the might of my power and for the glory of my majesty" (Daniel 4:30).

God had to give Nebuchadnezzar a lesson in "nation building." His punishment would be harsh. He would be turned into an animal. He was driven away from mankind and sentenced to eat grass like cattle. His hair grew like eagle's feathers and his nails like bird's claws. Could a man be brought any lower than that? Over time he learned a great lesson. God, not man, is ruler over the realm of mankind. Kings rise and fall at his direction. At the end of his sentence Nebuchadnezzar was able to see that.

We wring our hands in worry and ask "what is going to happen to our nation?" We worry over the "budget crisis", national security and a host of other problems. Rulers are easy targets of criticism. Is it possible that we need to learn the lesson of Romans 13:1? "Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God.

God is in charge. That's what Daniel told Nebuchadnezzar. That's what Paul reminds us. Therefore, we need to trust God. The mightiest nation can fall. History affirms that. Emotional energy spent worrying about an earthly kingdom could be better spent on the Kingdom of Heaven. "The kingdoms of earth pass away one by one, but the Kingdom of Heaven remains."

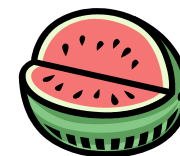

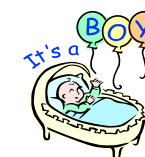
