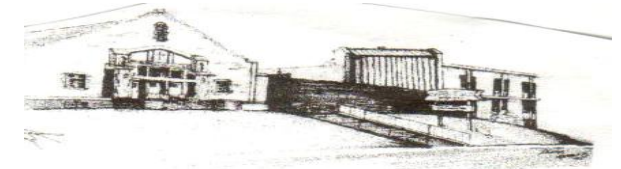

We apologize to those that we missed. In the future when bad weather requires cancellation of a service, members will be notified in the following ways:

1. Notice of cancellation will be emailed to those who wish to be notified by the internet. If the church office does not have your email, please give it to the church office. For those who use Facebook, a notice will be posted on the church's Facebook page.
2. Those with cell phones can be notified by text message. If the church office does not have your cell number, please let the church office know.
3. Notice of service cancellation will be broadcast over local radio Stations WDKN-AM 1260 khz (Dickson) & WQSE-AM 1030 khz (White Bluff) prior to the service.
4. We are also looking into a phone calling list but at this time, we do not have one developed.
5. If you are not sure about the weather, please call one of the elders before driving out into what may be hazardous conditions.

A few years ago, one church cancelled their Sunday evening services due to icy road conditions. One of their elders said, "We could have services tonight and if we did, a number of you would be here, but if someone fell on the ice or was injured in a car wreck, the elders would be second-guessing themselves why they had a service. We don't want anyone to get hurt."
