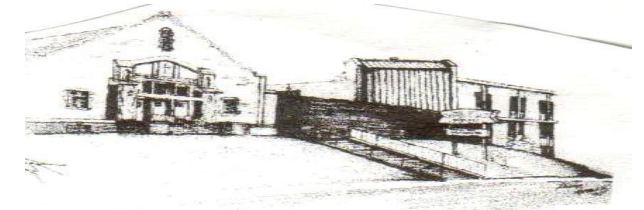

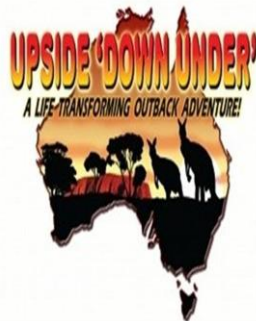
## VBS 2011 July 17<sup>th</sup> - 20
