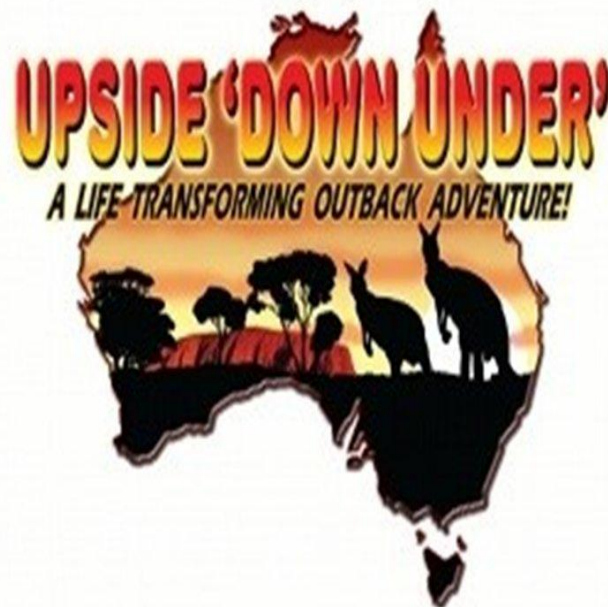

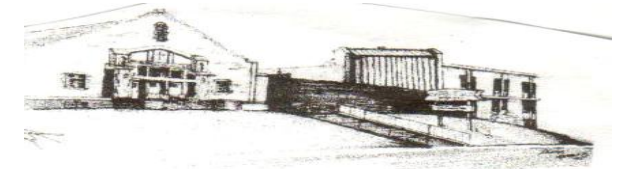

## From the Couch

**Secretary's Day.** Wednesday, April 27 was Secretary's Day. Thirty-four years ago, bro. Horace Turbeville asked Adelaide Butler to serve as church secretary. Six years ago, Lori Goodman also began serving this church. We are grateful for the myriad of things they do for the elders, deacons, ministers, & the church office. In so many ways, they are the front door to people who call the church for help or information. We love them & are deeply grateful for doing their work well. Be sure to express your appreciation for them in some way.

**Have You Been Washed in the Blood?** No man can be saved apart from the Cross of Jesus for it was there that Jesus shed His blood (John 19:34; 1 Peter 1:18-19). Even though Jesus "tasted death for every man" (Hebrews 2:9), not all men will be saved. Why? Because Jesus is the Author of eternal salvation to those who obey Him (Hebrews 5:9).

Part of our obedience is submitting to Jesus' command to be baptized (Mark 16:16; John 3:5). In baptism, we reenact the death, burial, & resurrection of Jesus (Romans 6:3-4). We die to sin (repentance), are buried in a watery grave (baptism), and are raised to live a new life (an obedient lifestyle). When submitting to baptism, we believe that God will take the blood of Christ and cleanse us from all our sins (Revelation 1:5).

Jesus is the Savior of the world (1 John 4:14) but baptism is part of our salvation (1 Peter 3:21-22) just like hope (Romans 8:24), belief (1 Corinthians 1:21), repentance (2 Peter 3:9), mercy (Titus 3:5), grace (Ephesians 2:8), Scripture (James 1:21), calling on the Lord's name (Acts 2:21), Christ's blood & life (Romans 5:9-10), and the gospel (1 Corinthians 15:2) are part of our salvation.

If you are interested in receiving "remission of sins," Jesus requires that you "repent and be baptized" (Acts 2:38).
