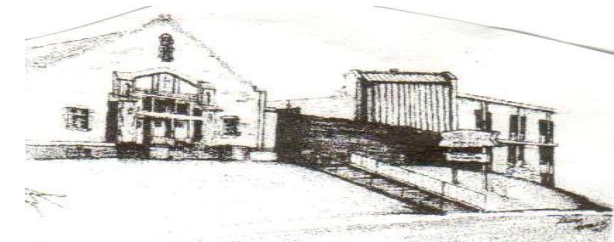

## NOT WHERE, BUT WHAT

Paul preached in Jewish synagogues and to gatherings of pagan philosophers. Pioneer preachers preached in Baptist, Methodist and community churches. It is a strange new thing that some now object to where a preacher preaches. Some will appear on a lectureship only if everyone on it already agrees with them on everything. The same people may preach for a church only if everything about it is all right before they go.

Why does one preach if not because there are some things he wants to see changed?

On the other hand, one may rightly be blamed for what he preaches. While it is not necessary to intentionally be so cantankerous as never to be invited back, if errors are flagrantly prevalent in a place, there is an obligation on anyone preaching there to try to move them at least somewhat toward needed correction.

If preaching for a church that does not know the difference between a burial and a sprinkle of rain, it may not be necessary to preach a whole sermon on baptism, but one should say something that would point them in the direction of the truth they need.

Similarity, if preaching for a congregation that does not welcome everyone regardless of race, one should speak a biblical word about preaching the gospel to every creature.

Some may have more problems with one of those scenarios than the other, but both equally need correcting.

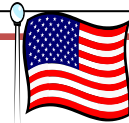
