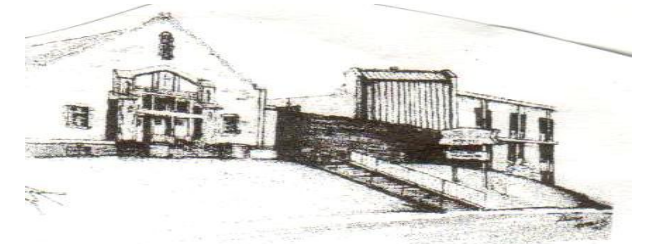

From the Elders: Marriage & Divorce

Marriage is sacred because it was instituted by God (Genesis 2:18-24). When God made man, He said, "It is not good for man to be alone," so God took from man a rib & made woman. God didn't take bone from man's head that he might rule over her, nor a bone from his foot that he might trample her, but from his side that they should stand side by side. What is God's plan for marriage? It is one man & one woman in one lifetime & there is one exception for divorce (fornication). Why did God design marriage?

1. Man's happiness (Gen. 2:18)
2. Continuation of the human race (Gen. 2:18)
3. Produce godly seed (Malachi 2:14,15)
4. Prevention of fornication (1 Cor. 7:1-2)
5. Complete satisfaction (Prov. 5:19; 1 Tim. 5:14)

What does the Bible say about how marriage can be dissolved?

1. Death (Romans 7:2-3).
2. Divorce where fornication took place. Today marriage is under attack from Satan, just as it was in the beginning. Under the Law of Moses, God allowed divorce due to the hardness of their hearts (Matt. 19:8). It seems as if we have hardened our hearts to God's Law & we have replaced it with man's law. In Matthew 19:9 Jesus said, "Whosoever shall put away his wife except it be for fornication & marries another commits adultery, & whoever marries the one put away commits adultery."

Who is eligible to marry?

1. Single person
2. One whose mate died (widowed)
3. A married person who divorced because the partner committed adultery against them

What about a person who lives in an abusive relationship or where drug & alcohol abuse makes marriage difficult? She can depart but if she does let her remain unmarried says the Lord. And husbands don't put away your wives (see 1 Cor. 7:10-11).

Who gets hurt when a divorce occurs? God, the church, both partners, their families, & the children (who are really hurt). There are more children being raised by single parents, grandparents, & great-grandparents than there has ever been.

Read Malachi 2:13-16 and you will see why God hates divorce.
