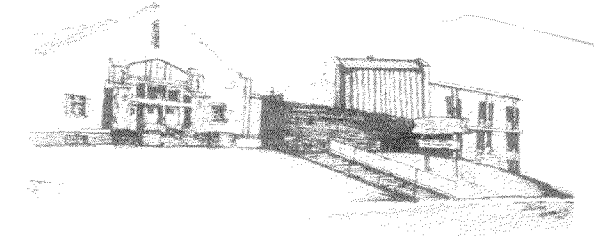

Is God Unconstitutional?

David Barton (b.1954) is a former teacher, principal, and founder of Wallbuilders, an organization whose goal is to influence government, schools, and families to incorporate Christian principles into their policies. State and federal legislators have consulted with him on legal-historical matters. He has participated in several cases before the U.S. Supreme Court.

In the early 1990's, Barton spoke in Murfreesboro, TN at a political rally. He told of a conversation he had with a U.S congressman who was sympathetic with him. The congressman said, "It would be great to have character education based on Christianity but we can't because of separation of church and state."

Barton objected, "Separation of church and state is NOT in the Constitution." "Yes it is," said the congressman. Barton handed him a copy of the Constitution and asked him to find it. Unable to find it, the embarrassed congressman admitted, "I have a law degree. We were never required to read the Constitution in law school. I always thought those words were there."

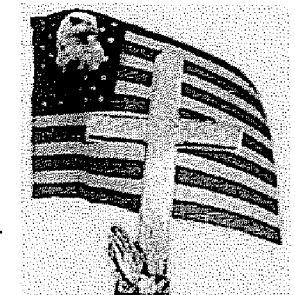

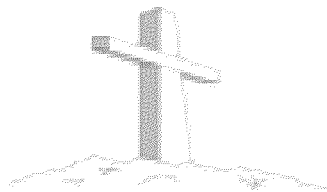
