**A NEW YEAR**

**A NEW BEGINNING**

The new year is a time for new beginnings. Have you ever wanted a second chance in life? Many people, for a variety of reasons, earnestly wish they could just start their lives over. We all have done things that we would do differently if we could go back in time.

But the thrilling reality is that God does offer us a second chance! In 2 Corinthians 5:17, the apostle Paul wrote, *“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.”*: Spiritually speaking, we can begin again in life. It is possible for us to have the forgiveness of sins so that, in the eyes of God, it is as though we never committed them. The guilt of sin is a heavy burden, but our Heavenly Father offers to remove that burden and make us a new creation.

How is that possible? Paul reminds us that to be a new creation, we must be “in Christ.” But how do we get into Christ? Paul gives us the answer in Galatians 3:26-27 which says, *“For you all are sons of Christ through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”* So we see that, by faith, we are baptized into Christ. In this way we put Christ on and become children of God. Have you been immersed into Christ so that you may become a new creation and have a new beginning with your Creator?
